





The United Nations Association in Canada invites you to share your ideas and beliefs on our interactive crowdmap! Edmonton is rich in diversity. Our communities are strengthened as we embrace people of different backgrounds and beliefs. This map provides an opportunity for Edmontonians to learn about the diversity within our City and to create an inclusive Edmonton.

### How to contribute a post

1. Click on “Submit a report” in the menu bar.
2. Fill in the fields with a red asterisk (\*).
  - a. Report title\*: Try to make this as descriptive as possible for potential readers
  - b. Description\*: Write about your beliefs, ideas regarding social issues or about an experience that you had. There is no maximum or minimum word count, but it is easiest to cut and paste your text into this field since there is no ability to save a draft.
  - c. Categories\*: Check the category or categories to which you think your story belongs (i.e. “Social Issues” or “Beliefs”).
  - d. Location Name\*: Use an address, name of the location or general description of the area.
  - e. News Source Link: Add a website link related to your post.
  - f. External Video Link: Add a link to a video (Youtube, Vimeo, etc.) related to your post.
  - g. Upload Photos: Add a photo related to your post.
  - h. Tips for marking a location on the Google Map:
    - i. Click on the “Clear map” button under the Google Map image (see red box in the image to the right).
    - ii. Select the “Hand Tool” and zoom into the map to locate the area you would like to mark.
    - iii. Select the “Pencil Tool” and click on the location that you want to mark.
    - iv. If you make a mistake, click “Delete last” to delete the last mark. You can also click “Clear map” and start again.
    - v. It is possible to mark several locations in one report.
    - vi. The “Find location” tool is currently under development and is not yet functional.



3. Click on the green “Submit” button on the bottom right side of the webpage.
4. Your story has been submitted to the moderator for approval! UNA-Canada reserves the right to not publish submissions that discriminate or support discrimination against individuals or groups.
